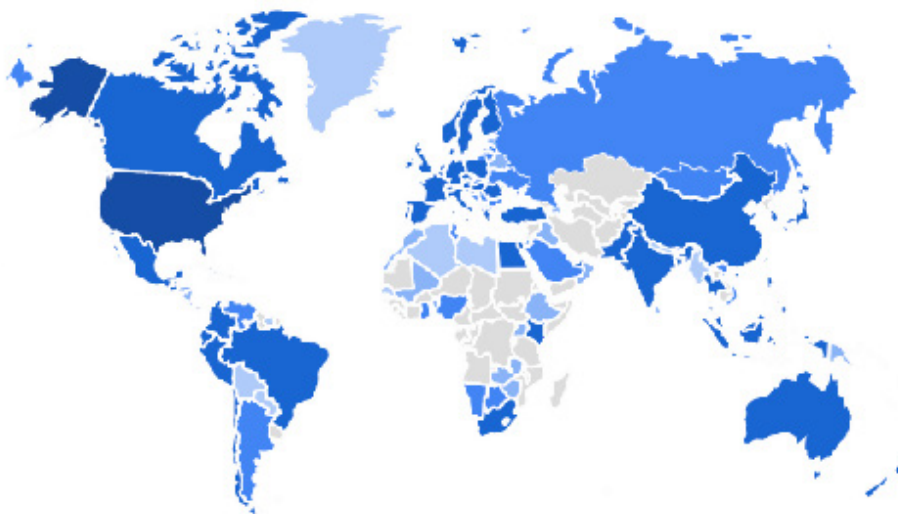

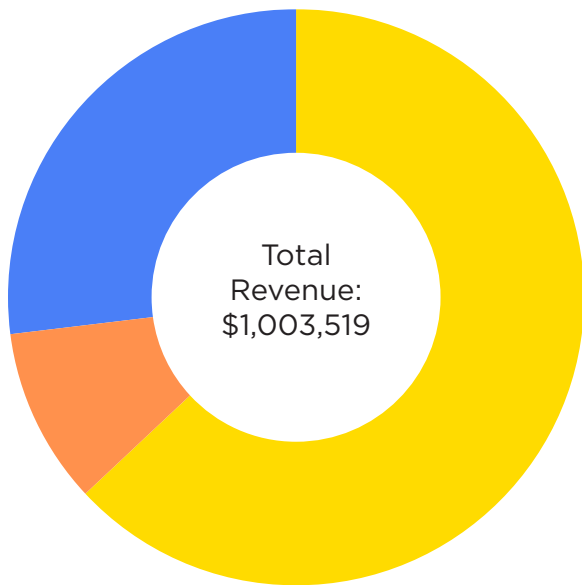

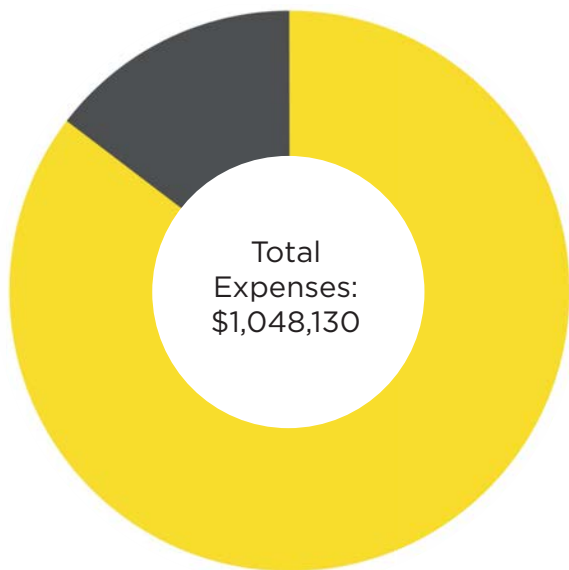

PHASE II CLINICAL TRIAL

In the United States, most clinical trials are funded by pharmaceutical companies, which have a vested interest in bringing new drugs to market. However, because mistletoe is a natural substance, it cannot be patented, making it difficult to secure funding for research. That's why Believe Big stepped in, rallying support through dinners, private donations, and events to fund this vital research.

Our goal is to complete all three phases of the clinical trial so that mistletoe therapy can be considered part of the standard of care in the U.S. and covered by insurance. This vision can only become a reality with your help.

Phase 1 of the trial has been completed, and we are now collaborating with researchers at Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine and German experts to design Phase 2, which is estimated to cost \$1 million. Phase 3 is expected to require \$5-8 million.

- A conducive environment to quiet one's spirit, leave the demands of daily life, and be free to seek and deepen a spiritual connection with Christ

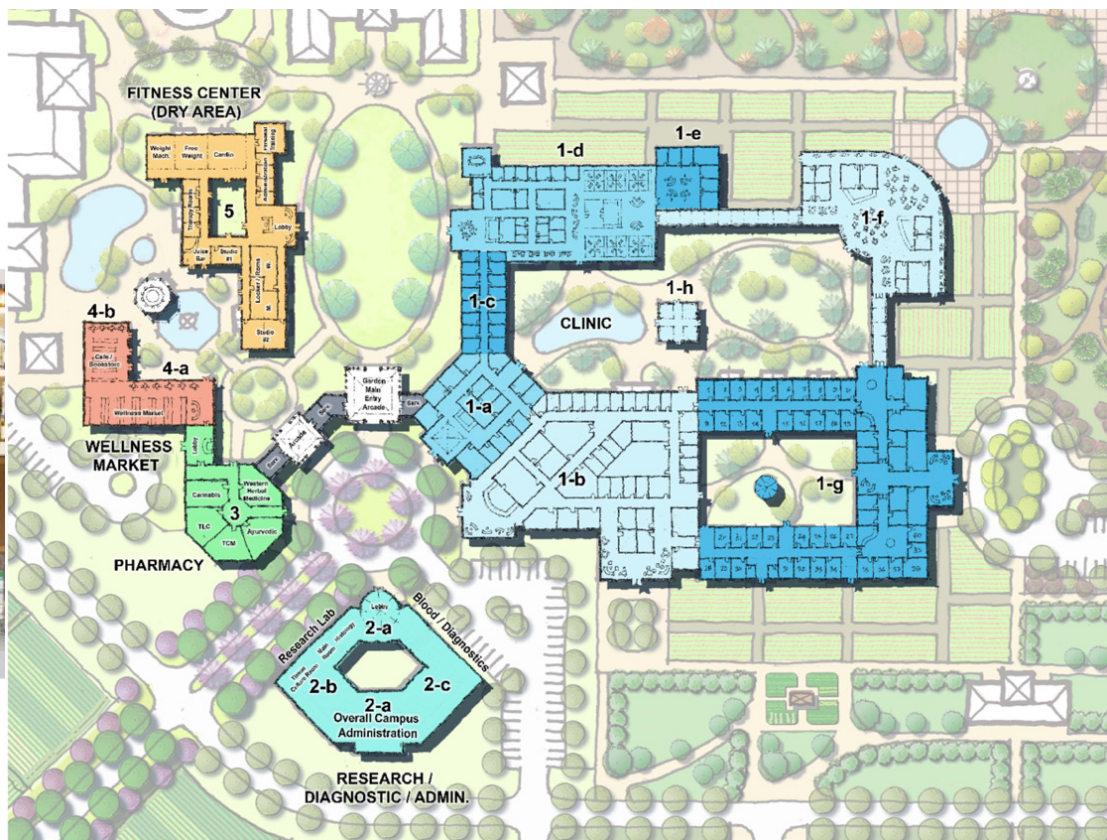
Patient Care

We exist to upgrade the "standard of care" for cancer by moving from the trial and error approach inherent in set protocols:

- 1. EVALUATE** - Before undergoing any treatment, we assess patients' complete biomedical workup, epigenetic blueprint, personal and family history, and lifestyle influences that contributed to or are driving their disease process.

2. TRANSLATE - Our unique ability to translate this information can take the guesswork out of treatment and guide patients to use the correct medications and interventions at the right time throughout their treatment.

3. TREAT - Patients will have access to vetted and research-supported therapies along with re-envisioned standard of care in one place.

4. INFORM - The data and analytics from our research will provide scientific evidence to inform cancer treatment for practitioners and patients well beyond our walls.

STORIES OF HOPE



BEN ABELL STAGE IV PROSTATE CANCER

At 62, Ben Abell believed he was living a healthy, active life centered on faith, family, exercise and meaningful work. Then an unexpected phone call changed everything: he had aggressive stage IV prostate cancer.

The diagnosis shocked Ben, his wife, Laura, and even his physician. His cancer registered a nine out of ten on the Gleason scale. Yet in those first frightening moments, Ben and Laura chose prayer over panic and began asking, What is the next right step?

Ben received hormone therapy, surgery and 33 rounds of radiation through Johns Hopkins. treatment he credits with saving his life. But he soon realized that conventional medicine was only one part of the support he needed to heal and thrive.

That realization led him to Believe Big.

Through Believe Big, Ben discovered integrative cancer care and gained access to trusted resources, practitioners and education about nutrition, metabolic health and complementary therapies. He worked with an integrative physician and a cancer-focused nutritionist, and mistletoe therapy became an important part of his personalized care plan.

Believe Big also helped Ben become a more informed and confident participant in his healing. He learned that each person's cancer journey is unique and that integrative care can support the whole person, physically, emotionally and spiritually, alongside conventional treatment.

Throughout the journey, Ben drew strength from prayer, Scripture, family and community. His wife, four children and ten grandchildren gave him a powerful reason to keep moving forward.

When asked what helped him most, Ben named four things: prayer, becoming informed, working with an integrative expert and making nutrition a central part of his healing environment.

Today, Ben has no evidence of disease and says he feels better than he has ever felt. His experience has made him an advocate for a future in which conventional and integrative medicine work together to care for the whole person.

Ben's story also reflects the impact of every Believe Big supporter.

"Somebody gave years ago so that I could receive the goodness of the resources that you have," Ben shared. "It is worth sacrificing for others so that they can also be healed."

Because of generous donors, Believe Big can continue providing free education, practitioner connections, spiritual support and hope to patients and families facing cancer. Ben received that support when he needed it most, and today, he is helping pay that hope forward.

Last summer, Nathalie Mulinix was diagnosed with stage IV ovarian cancer. When she first heard the diagnosis, she found herself hoping it might be something else. “Maybe it’s just an infection?” she wondered. But the doctor gently said, “No, I’m sorry.”

In that moment, time seemed to slow down, while her mind began to race. She thought about her family, her future, her son, the things she had not done yet, and the reality that so much of her life had been spent taking care of everything and everyone except herself.

Then something inside of her said, There has to be another way to heal. Not just fight. Not just survive. But truly heal.

Through Believe Big Nathalie learned about mistletoe therapy. At first, mistletoe was something she associated with the holidays, but she soon discovered that in integrative medicine, it is used to support the immune system and help the body do what it was designed to do.

Nathalie made the decision to trust the process, trust her body, and trust God. In August, her CA-125 tumor marker was 1,968. Just five weeks later, it dropped to 35.

For Nathalie, it was not just a number that changed. Something returned that she did not even realize she had lost: hope.

But her healing did not stop there. She began to look at her life more deeply: the stress she had been carrying, the relationships that were draining her, and the constant cycle of doing, achieving, and pushing. She realized her body was not only asking her to heal physically. It was asking her to come back to herself.

That is why Believe Big’s mission matters. Healing is not one-dimensional. Patients need access, education, options, and most importantly, belief. Belief that the body is capable of more. Belief that there are options. Belief that healing is possible, even when it feels impossible.

Today, Nathalie’s story is a reminder to every patient and family facing something hard: healing is about more than adding years to your life. It is about bringing life back into your years.

Nathalie chose to believe that hope and healing were possible. And her story reminds us why Believe Big continues to walk alongside patients with faith, education, and support every step of the way.

I met Ivelisse at a dinner party at the Waldorf Astoria in DC after the Medal of Freedom ceremony for Charlie Kirk. Fate brought us together. We were seated next to each other, and I overheard her speaking with a gentleman about colon cancer.

When their conversation ended, I told her that my husband, Kevin, had passed away from colorectal cancer on September 30, 2022. Looking back, I truly believe Kevin had a hand in that meeting. Ivelisse shared that she was a colon cancer survivor and told me how Believe Big had grown out of her own journey. I remember thinking, “This is exactly what Kevin and I had been searching for.”

When Kevin was diagnosed, we were blessed with great health insurance and the means to go to any doctor or hospital we wanted. We realized that not everyone was that fortunate. My late husband believed in giving back. When he sold his software company, he founded the Kehoe Family Foundation. We gave grants to nonprofits focused on education, helping military veterans, and cancer.

When the Mayo Clinic told us there were no more traditional treatments, we turned to integrative medicine. We were too late for Kevin, but when I heard Believe Big was helping patients discover alternative options, I knew I had to offer my support. I made my first donation of \$100,000.

Several months later, Ivelisse reached out to ask for my opinion about a telemedicine program that would connect cancer patients with doctors. I was all in. Having sat in countless waiting rooms, I knew this program could help eliminate the burden of traveling while sick. When I asked how much this endeavor would cost, I was amazed that it would be less than \$150,000. I told her I would fund the program.

What I love most about Believe Big is that they care for the whole person. They provide patient grants, guidance, and access to integrative therapies, including mistletoe therapy.

Supporting Believe Big allows me to carry forward Kevin's legacy of helping others. I am honored, on his behalf, to support an organization that truly changes lives. I highly recommend Believe Big to anyone looking for a great cause to support.
