





CLINICAL TRIAL UPDATE

The mistletoe clinical trial was a phase one trial conducted to test the safety and toxicity of a new drug. The study design included dose escalations to determine the maximum tolerated dose. The drug was treated like any other drug that undergoes clinical trials, and the goal was to ensure that the drug was safe and well-tolerated in patients. The mistletoe trial enrolled 21 patients, who were selected from a screening process that included over a hundred individuals. The patients received the drug at increasing doses, and the maximum tolerated dose was found to be 600 milligrams IV three times a week. This dose was recommended for further testing in phase two trials. The trial also included a quality-of-life survey, which was added to gather pilot data and determine what should be done in the next phases of the trial. The survey showed that the drug improved the quality of life of the patients, which was an unexpected result for a phase one trial. The patients reported feeling better, despite their advanced cancer, which was a positive

outcome for the trial. In terms of efficacy, five of the 21 patients had stable disease, and three of the patients had tumor shrinkage. This is a promising result for a phase one trial, which is not designed to measure efficacy. Our next step is to raise the \$1 million dollars needed for phase 2 that will focus on how mistletoe affects the growth of cancer cells and quality of life.

The problem that most cancer patients are experiencing.

- Don't think they have time to investigate other options not knowing that it typically takes cancer seven to ten years to grow in the first place.
- Are so overwhelmed with just being diagnosed that they aren't sure of even what questions to ask or that there is a better way where they can complement treatments and have a great quality and quantity of life.
- Are trying to figure out how they are going to be able to sustain their family financially.
- Hear the word cancer, and they are instantly filled with fear as the only picture they see in their mind is of someone who is suffering and weak.

- **4. INFORM -** The data and analytics from our research will provide scientific evidence to inform cancer treatment for practitioners and patients well beyond our walls.






STORIES OF HOPE

STAGE IV BREAST CANCER, STAGE I LUNG CANCER, AND STAGE I THROAT CANCER



Believe Big not only provided the information and resources I needed, including grant money, they offered me kindness and compassion. Thanks to the support of Believe Big and integrative treatment, along with surgery, chemo, and radiation, I was cancer free for almost 5 years!

Then, in early 2019, I had been suffering from a severe sore throat that was initially diagnosed as strep throat. After 2 rounds of antibiotics and no relief, I quickly scheduled a biopsy with an ENT doctor.

A few days later, after an oncology check-up and feeling happy that all was well, I got the news that stunned me... I had throat cancer. My doctor told me a portion of my throat needed to be removed. Now, I was petrified.

I called my husband before heading home. I held back the tears knowing I had to drive home, but as soon as I was in the arms of my husband, I cried my eyes out. I thought I had just heard some of the worst news of my life. Little did I know, that was only the tip of the iceberg.

After having a PET scan, CT scans, and biopsies, it was determined that I not only had small cell throat cancer, I also had a cancerous nodule in my right lung and metastatic breast cancer lesions in my liver. I now had stage 4 breast cancer, stage 1 lung cancer, and stage 1 throat cancer.

In the weeks to follow, I had surgeries to remove the tumors in my throat and lung and radiation to the cancerous lesions in my liver. Meanwhile, the lymph nodes in my neck became swollen and when biopsied, found to be stage 4 metastatic throat cancer. Therefore, besides the 12 rounds of chemo I was scheduled for, my treatment now included 7 weeks of daily head and neck radiation treatments. I felt overwhelmed and wondered if I was going to make it through all of this.

In the midst of this chaos, I reached out to Believe Big. Even when the odds seemed impossible to overcome, Believe Big gave me hope and support. They connected me with integrative mistletoe physicians. They again provided grant money which enabled me to receive therapies that helped me endure the rigorous treatment schedule and to enhance my healing from two stage 4 cancers and one stage 1 cancer. I have been healed for an amazing 4 years now!

I credit Believe Big for being an essential part of my recovery. And as important as Believe Big's information, knowledge, and grants were to my healing, what I appreciate most about Believe Big is their kindness and compassion towards me. They were there for me every step of the way, praying with me and for me, offering comfort, and cheering me on when I was terrified.

Yes, they are an incredible resource for integrative anti-cancer therapies and offer practical steps to take toward regaining health, but they also extended themselves and offered me true hope, which was vital and life-affirming. Believe Big inspired and motivated me to be unstoppable! Their great work is possible because of your contributions and support! So, thank you so much for helping me, and please continue to enable Believe Big to provide this same hope and inspiration to other cancer patients.



My name is Daniel Wellington. In 2019 I had a surprise finding of a stage IV sarcoma. I came to find out that it started in my hip and then metastasized to my lungs. After traveling around the country to multiple sarcoma centers, I learned that my cancer was very rare (100 cases a year) and has no effective conventional treatment. Finding out I had cancer was hard as many in this room know, but hearing that there were no answers for me, was a feeling I can't quite put to words. Given the tough prognosis, I felt alone and directionless. There was a lot to be digested, but the deep dive I did into reading books like Radical Remission and Starve Cancer resulted in a material shift from hopelessness to empowerment and tangible steps. I continue to be fascinated by the immense field of non-conventional treatments and learned about mistletoe therapy.

Coincidentally, a friend of my wife brought up Mistletoe Therapy and the great work being done at Believe Big. We made the connection and before I knew it, Believe Big gave me great information about next steps, introduced me to my integrative oncologist, and gave me a grant to offset that visit and my first mistletoe shots. I was very impressed by Believe Big's genuine concern and willingness to be there for me. While my selfhealing journey did not start with Believe Big, I quickly came to realize just how valuable this organization is to cancer patients and their support teams. When I think of the daunting task of finding the right contacts, understanding the complexities of nutrition, the impact of toxins found in everything, the immense value of mindfulness, the introduction of supplements, various unconventional treatments, and the anxiety that came with trying to understand all of that... and then trying to put it together into an action plan...the real world practical need for Believe Big becomes obvious. It can be an almost impossible task to organically build your own treatment plan, but thankfully, Believe Big has done much of the work for us.

The doctors said I would be incapacitated at the end of four years. That will be one month from now. I didn't ask what exactly "incapacitated" meant in this context because I didn't want to know, but I'm pretty sure that me standing here today means that I'm ahead of my prognosis. It's still important to me that I live a long life, but I am thrilled to have arrived at a place where laughing often and living well with my beautiful wife and five children are a greater priority than just surviving. Is my cancer gone? No. Am I healing? Yes, absolutely! ... in ways that I could never have imagined.

Almost half the people you know at some point will need Believe Big's services in the future. What a comfort to know that they will be there for those we love. And, by giving generously we can be there to help Believe Big continue this vital work.
