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





PHASE II CLINICAL TRIAL

In the United States, most clinical trials are funded by pharmaceutical companies, which have a vested interest in bringing new drugs to market. However, because mistletoe is a natural substance, it cannot be patented, making it difficult to secure funding for research. That's why Believe Big stepped in-rallying support through dinners, private donations, and events to fund this vital research.


Our goal is to complete all three phases of the clinical trial so that mistletoe therapy can be considered part of the standard of care in the U.S. and covered by insurance. This vision can only become a reality with your help.

Phase 1 of the trial has been completed, and we are now collaborating with researchers at Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine and German experts to design Phase 2, which is estimated to cost \$1 million. Phase 3 is expected to require \$5-8 million.

Problems Many Cancer Patients Experience

Once diagnosed, patients:

- Are immediately rushed on a conveyor belt of treatment with only three options: chemotherapy, radiation, and surgery.
- Don't realize that their care should be individualized and not standardized.
- Don't think they have time to investigate other options not knowing that it typically takes cancer seven to ten years to grow in the first place.
- Are so overwhelmed with just being diagnosed that they aren't sure of what questions to ask or that there is a better way where they can complement treatments and have a great quality and quantity of life.
- Are trying to figure out how they are going to be able to sustain their family financially.
- Hear the word cancer, and they are instantly filled with fear as the only picture they see in their mind is of someone who is suffering and weak.



- **2. TRANSLATE -** Our unique ability to translate this information can take the guesswork out of treatment and guide patients to use the correct medications and interventions at the right time throughout their treatment.
- **3. TREAT -** Patients will have access to vetted and research-supported therapies along with re-envisioned standard of care in one place.
- **4. INFORM -** The data and analytics from our research will provide scientific evidence to inform cancer treatment for practitioners and patients well beyond our walls.

ANDY MUSSER

STAGE III COLON CANCER

In 2014, Andy Musser's life was full of promise. He had recently joined his family's business, moved into a new home with his fiancée, Erica, and embraced the role of a father figure to her daughter, Madison. Their joy multiplied when they learned they were expecting a baby. But just one week later, everything changed.

After a sudden allergic reaction to a yellow jacket sting, Andy's routine bloodwork revealed dangerously low hemoglobin levels. Further testing uncovered a tumor in his colon. At just 31 years old, he was misdiagnosed with stage 4 cancer—news that sent shockwaves through his family. But a second opinion brought a new perspective and, ultimately, a correct diagnosis: stage III colon cancer.

Determined to fight, Andy turned to his faith and sought every possible path to healing. That's when he found Believe Big. With the support of a Believe Big Mistletoe Grant, Andy gained access to integrative cancer care, combining traditional chemotherapy with mistletoe therapy and a nutrition-based approach. He embraced healing with acupuncture, juicing, and dietary changes to strengthen his body during treatment.

Through it all, Andy leaned on prayer, visualization, and unwavering faith. The treatments worked. He tolerated chemotherapy well, and in 2015, as he completed his final round of treatment, his daughter, Olivia Hope, was born—a living testament to the strength of faith and perseverance.

Today, nearly a decade cancer-free, Andy leads a healthy, active life, prioritizing fitness, nutrition, and mental well-being. He even leads a men's group to encourage others to reach their goals and manage stress.

Andy's journey would not have been possible without Believe Big and the generosity of donors like you. As the number of people seeking integrative cancer care continues to rise, we need your help to ensure that every patient receives the hope, healing, and resources they deserve.

Just one month after settling into their first home—and six months pregnant with their third son—Melissa and Jason Jacobi never imagined how drastically life could change in a single afternoon.

What started as a sunny summer day filled with laughter and backyard fun turned into a nightmare. Their two-year-old son, Luca, spiked a 104-degree fever and suddenly had a seizure on the couch. Within moments, Jason and Melissa were calling 911. After initial tests at the local hospital, Luca was urgently transferred to CHOC Children's Hospital, where they received the devastating diagnosis: Luca had Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia (ALL)—an aggressive form of blood cancer.

The treatment road ahead would be long: 2 to 3 years of intensive chemotherapy, procedures, and countless hospital visits. In the midst of this overwhelming time, the Jacobis found support and hope through Believe Big.

Thanks to a Believe Big grant, the family connected with an integrative pediatric oncology specialist who helped them create a complementary plan alongside Luca's conventional treatment. This included supplements, CBD and hemp oils, and individualized nutrition—all carefully aligned with his medical care. Genetic testing also helped guide personalized treatment strategies to better support his body's healing process.

"Believe Big helped us slow down, breathe, and take it one step at a time," Melissa shared. "We felt like we had a partner walking beside us—not just in treatment, but in hope."

The grant also helped cover the cost of virtual doctor visits and supplements, easing the financial burden of care. Through this integrative approach, Luca's energy and joy began to return. "He's thriving today," Jason said. "He's outside playing, riding scooters, scraping his knees—he looks and feels like any other little boy. You wouldn't know he's in remission and still in treatment."

For the Jacobis, faith has been their anchor. "This journey brought us to our knees, but it also brought us closer to God and to each other," Melissa said. "There is peace even in the storm."

Because of supporters like you, Believe Big continues to provide families like the Jacobis with practical resources, integrative support, and financial relief at one of the hardest times of their lives.

Since we last connected about four months ago, I've undergone four rounds of chemotherapy, radiation, daily targeted medication, and surgery to remove part of my lung. With the help of my integrative oncologist, I've been using mistletoe and helleborus alongside conventional treatments. Today, my integrative oncologist shared that my latest Signatera test shows undetectable tumor cells, dropping from a score of 22.31 in June to 0.00 in September. Additionally, my medical oncologist informed me post-surgery that my pathology report shows no sign of cancer. Just over six months ago, I was diagnosed with stage IV lung cancer. Now, two tests show no evidence of disease. I am thankful for Believe Big's support in accessing mistletoe and helleborus, which have significantly contributed to this outcome. While my journey continues, and I plan to keep using natural remedies to heal and strengthen my immune system, I am interested in any further grant opportunities from Believe Big for long-term support.
